

FREQUENTLY ASKED QUESTIONS

1. Who is eligible to study M.B.B.S. in Medical Colleges in China ?

Any Indian citizen who has attained the age of 17 years and has passed 10+2 level from any recognized Council/Board of India or abroad. He/she must have studied Physics, Chemistry, Biology as elective subjects and obtained minimum 55 % in aggregate of PCB combined. Also must studied and passed English as a Compulsory Subject.

2. How do I get an eligibility from MCI ?

If one satisfies the above requirement then he/she can apply in prescribed format to MCI. MCI on due appraisal at their end shall issue necessary certificate. We shall assist in this.

3. Does every body gets MCI Eligibility ?

Yes subject to Para-1.

4. Can I practice in India on my return ?

Yes you can practice in India in order to practice as a medical practitioner you have to register yourself with the state or Indian Medical Council. For this you have to appear for a screening test. On clearing the screening test you are eligible for Registration as a Doctor and allowed to practice at par with all other Doctors.

5. Can I get a job in Government Hospitals or allied medical Institutions in India ?

Yes after clearing the Screening test and getting your Registration with the State or Central Council you are eligible for any Government appointment.

6. What happens if I fail to clear the Screening Test of MCI ?

Normally a student who passes MBBS from a WHO recognized college is expected to clear this test. One can also take coaching towards preparation for the same. One can get even unlimited chances, so it is not likely to be deterrent factor.

7. Do I have to learn Chinese ?

Not for your MBBS program. The education will be in ENGLISH medium . But I suggest you learn Chinese so that you can communicate with your Chinese Friends and locals. This will make your stay more comfortable , This will also help in conversation with the patients during your

Intrenship program. Also there is a big demand for people who can speak both Chinese and English.

8. Do any Indian Professors Teach there ?

Yes a lot of foreign professors teach there. Many of them are from India, Sri Lanka, Bangladesh and Nepal.

9. Do I have to eat only Chinese Food always ?

The food there is very similar to ours. Rice is the staple Food, All popular vegetables like potato, Brinjal, Cauliflower, Cabbage , Beans , Carrots , Cucumber etc. are available. Similarly Egg, Fish , Chicken , Mutton are also abundant.

Indian style Roties available in special Restaurants. But Bread, Cookies, Pastries, Ice creams, Canned juices are available in plenty in all the college canteens and Dining Halls.

10. How many times can I come to my Home land in a Year?

There are 2 vacations Winter and Summer. The Winter vacation is around the last week of January and normally for about 2 to 3 weeks . I suggest you enjoy China during this period. The Summer vacation is normally about 6 weeks and around August/September and you can easily come to your home during that period. That is also the end of term. However the travel by air takes totally about 7-8 hours from any where in India with some intermittent time during flight change over.

11. Are there many Indian Students Studying ?

Yes many students are studying there. Apart from Indian students there are lot of students from SAARC countries.

12. Can I get Bank Loan and to what extent ?

As per RBI regulation an Indian student pursuing education abroad can obtain Bank Loan up to 15 Lakhs INR Since the cost of the entire program is well within that, the entire amount can be funded from Bank Loan.

13. Can I get help for Bank loan from you ?

We can certainly advise and guide but a Branch of any bank near to the residence of the candidate has to be approached.

14. What is the course duration?

Same as in India 5 Years of Study and 1 Year of Internship (Optional). Total 6 years.

15. How is the weather and climate ?

The climate is very similar to India. Tropical Climate with regional variations.

16. Is the Course approved by MCI ?

MCI cannot approve any foreign Degree, But they Conduct Screening Test and allow successful candidates to register with them and practice in India.

17. Is it approved by WHO?

Yes the college and the program is approved by WHO and recognized by Government of China.

18. What is the medium of study ?

The medium of Instruction shall be English . However Chinese language class is included in the First Year. This is to make a students stay comfortable by enabling him to communicate with the localies.

19. Where can I do my Intrenship ?

You can do it in the college at China. They will also allow you to do it in your Homeland. The Hospital must be recognized by Government and on due certification the college shall confer the final MBBS degree.

20. How many Foreign student are studying there and How many from India ?

Lot of foreign students are studying in China and many are from India.

21. What will be the Total Expenditure Including Hostel and Food e.t.c. ?

Please refer to cost estimate available with your counselor.

22. Can I do MD/MS I mean Post Graduation there?

Yes on successful completion of MBBS you can pursue PG courses there.

23. What will be the procedure of Admission ?

First you have to provide us your all documents like 10th, 11th, 12th Marksheets and Passing Certificates, Original Passport and Passport size photo. Then we will apply for your admission in MCI listed college from China. After Registration and application process is duly completed your Visa application will be processed by the college, On Receipt of Visa your travel plan will be finalized and confirmed admission order will be issued in your favour. Mean while, we will assist you to get done with your Eligibility from MCI.

24. How to get Visa ? Will you help me and or obtain for me ?

Yes we shall process your visa application.

25. What will be the mode of payment and in what currency ?

All payments will be calculated in RMB (Reminbi). However you may pay in INR if you pay in India. At china your Food and other miscellaneous expenses has to be paid by you in RMB= Chinese Yuan.

26. How much time is required to reach the college from India?

If properly planned one can reach within 1 day.

27. What is the mode of travel and cost ?

Mode of travel shall be by air departure from major metros via Hongkong, Shanghai, Beijing depending on convenience and availability
